The Drill was aimed at ensuring prompt response by the various teams and rescuers during disastrous events such as rescuing trapped people, checking response and functionality of equipment, communication sets, etc. and to establish Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for Cave Evacuation.



The main trainers were the members of the Meghalaya Adventurers Association, who were trained in cave evacuation and rescue in the UK and Ireland. Prior to the day of the exercise, a session was held at the DRDA Hall, Shillong among all stakeholders and participants, whereby the Meghalaya Adventurers Association (MAA) briefed on the roles and techniques of rescue teams in the event of disasters like earthquake etc. in cave.
