Interstate Border Meeting Held

Shillong, March, 27, 2024: In view of the Inter-State Border and other law and order related issues for the upcoming Lok Sabha Elections, Meghalaya Chief Secretary, Shri. D.P. Wahlang, IAS today chaired a meeting with the Additional Chief Secretary Home (Police) Department, Dr. Shakil P.
