No.FEM.18/84/13.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Salaries Act, 1972 (Act 4 of 1972), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to make the following amendments to the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules), namely.—

THE MEGHALAYA MINISTERS' (ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (FOURTEENTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 1984

1. Short title and commencement:—(1) These Rules may be called Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) (Fourteenth Amendment) Rules, 1984.

2. They shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 20th day of September, 1984.

3. Amendment of Rule 8:—In the principal Rules—(i) for the words "twenty thousand eight hundred fifty" wherever occurring in Government rules (1) and (2) of rule 3, the words "sixty thousand" shall be substituted, and (ii) after the existing sub-rule (2) of rule 3, the following shall be inserted as new sub-rule (3), names.—

> "(3) The Ministers who have not been allotted Government accommodation shall also be entitled to selecting items of furnishing from the approved list and within the approved ceiling. On relinquishing their charge, they shall return those articles to the furnishing pool of the Estate Officer, Shillong".
