No.FEM.64/85/71.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 8 and 10 of the Meghalava Ministers' (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1972 (Act 4 of 1972), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to make the following Rules further to amend the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules), namely:—

## THE MEGHALAYA MINISTERS' (ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (SIXTEENTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 1986.

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These Rules may be called the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) (Sixteenth Amendment) Rules, 1986.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 1st day of July, 1985.

2. Amendment of rule 7.—In rule 7 of the principal rules, in clause (ii), for the words "Rupees one hundred and fifty" the words "Rupees two hundred" shall be substituted.

3. Amendment of rule 3.—In rule 8 of the principal rule, for the words "rupces two thousand" occurring between the words "Lump Sum of" and "provided" the words "rupces four thousand" shall be substituted.

4. Amendment of rule 22.—In rule 22 of principal rules, in clause (b), for the figures and words "175 litres", the figures and words "200 litres", shall be substituted.
