To authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Meghalaya for the services of financial year 1988-89

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Meghalaya in the Fortieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title and Commencement	1.	This Act may be called the Meghalaya Appropriation (No. I) Act, 1989.
Withdrawal of Rs. 17,11,62,509 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Meghalaya for the financial year 1988-89	2.	From and out of the Consolidated Fund of Meghalaya there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column (3) of the Scheduled amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rupees seventeen crores, eleven lakhs, sixty two thousand, five hundred nine rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the financial year 1988-89 in respect of the services specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.
Appropriation	3.	The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Meghalaya by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

Short title and Commencement

- (1) This Act may be called the Meghalaya Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 1989
 - (2) It shall come into force on the first day of April, 1989

Withdrawal of Rs.
