## further to amend Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1972.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Meghalaya in the Thirty-ninth year of th: Republic of India as follows:-

Short title I. (1) This Act may be called the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and . Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1938.

(2) It shall come into force on and from 1st day of August, 1988.

Amendment 2. In Section 2 of the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya of Section 2 (Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and Allowan es) Act of Act 2 of 1972 (hereinofter referred to as the principal Act), for the words "rupees two thousand" and "rupers one thousand nine hundred" the words " rupers four the sand four hundred" and "rupees four thousand" respectively shall be substituted. 3. For Section 4 of the principal Act, including the marginal of Section 4 of Act 2 of note thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely---1972.
