ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR**

ORDER

No. PER.62/2020/18

Dated: Shillong, the 23rd March, 2020

In pursuance of The Meghalaya Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 issued by the Health and Family Welfare Department vide No.Health.68/2020/38 dated 19th March 2020, it is hereby directed that all **Parents of students who are Government employees and whose wards have returned from outside the State should stay in home isolation** and adhere to the Regulations and all advisories of the Health and Family Welfare Department issued from time to time.

In particular attention is drawn to Regulation 5 of the above Regulations which states that:

“5 i. In case the person has any such history in last 14 days and the person is asymptomatic then the person must be kept in “stay at home” for 14 days from the day of exposure.

ii. In case the person has any such history in last 14 days and the person is symptomatic as per case definition of COVID-19, the person must be isolated in a hospital and will be tested for COVID-19 as per protocol.

iii. Information of all such cases should be given to office of the District Medical & Health Officer/District Control Room of the respective District immediately”

Further, the such parents should ensure that their wards fill in the Self-Declaration on the portal <http://meghalayaonline.gov.in/covid/login.htm>.
