**ORDER**

In pursuant to the Order of Home (Political) Department, Government of Meghalaya vide POL.75/2020/PtI/111 dated 20.08.2021 and DC Order issued vide No.C&S.2/CVD/2021/ORD/280 dated 28/08/2021, the following arrangement is made for opening of Shops within the Pynursla Civil Sub-Division, East Khasi Hills District:-

1. Identified shops dealing in essential commodities as notified by the Incident Commanders / Zonal Magistrates under each Zone in Pynursla Civil Sub-Division will open not more than 6 (six) time a week i.e. Monday to Saturday and considering the local market calendar days.
2. Non-essentials shops may be permitted to open, each upto 5 (five) times a week, on day i.e. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday.
3. Shop may open from upto to 6:00 PM on each day and shall remain closed on Sundays.
4. Cyber cafes, book shops and stationeries are permitted to open six days a week in line with the days schedule of essential shops.
5. Teer counters and archery are permitted to open from Monday to Friday.
6. Restaurants / bars are permitted to open for customers at 50% seating capacity starting from 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2021, with strict compliance to SOPs issued by the Tourism Department and by this office. They shall intimate and furnish the vaccination status of all employees prior to opening to the Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) / Block Development Officer / Incident Commander concerned.
7. All shops / restaurants / bars will place a prominent sign / poster indicating vaccination status of the shopkeepers and staff at the shop premises.
8. Shops / restaurants are encouraged to opt for home – delivery of items, whenever possible.
9. The Headmen, Market Committee and CCMTs will be responsible for ensuring absolute adherence to protocols.
10. The Shopkeepers and the public should strictly adhere to the following protocols while making their purchase:-
  - a. Everyone should wear double – masks (3-ply plus cloth mask) or N95 mask without fail.
  - b. Social distancing of at least 2 meters should be strictly maintained by all.
  - c. People are not permitted to loiter in the market area without any valid reasons.
  - d. Anyone found violating protocols will be liable for shop-closure or fined.
  - e. There shall be no overcrowding in one area / shop and people should spend minimum time in the shop / market area.
