ORDER

In pursuance to Order No. POL.75/2020/Pt.I/113 dated. 3rd September, 2021 issued by the Home (Political) Department, Government of Meghalaya, Shillong in the interest of regulating movement within the district and ease of enforcing strict SOP issued by the Government, the following arrangement of vehicular movement is made for East Khasi Hills District from 6th September, 2021 between 5:00Am and 8:00Pm and until further orders as follows:

- I. Private transport is permitted @ 100% within curfew relaxation hours.
- II. Public transport plying within the district, i.e., City Bus, Mini Bus including SSTS & SPTS Buses, Local Taxi, Auto-Rickshaw and Maxi Cabs (SSPTS) and Inter-district vehicles holding All Meghalaya Tourist Permit (Swift, Alto, Tiago, Ertiga, Lodgy, Sumo Maxx etc) are permitted @50% per day subject to the following conditions:-
 - (a) Vehicles registered in and originating from East Khasi Hills District will report to DTO, Shillong for submission and issuance of vaccination status and strictly adhere to the following arrangement when plying within and out of the district.

Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday	Vehicles ending with 1, 3, 5, 7 & 9

Local Taxi	1 + 3
Auto Rickshaw	1 + 2
SSPTS	1 + 5
5 seater	1 + 3
7seater	1 + 5
11 seater	1 + 7

- (b) Vehicles registered in and originating from other districts will prominently display their vaccination status issued by the competent authority on the vehicle and ply as per arrangement made by the respective Deputy Commissioner for entering the district.
- III. Vaccination Status should be **clearly indicated** on the vehicles as per this office order No. C&S.2/CVD/2021/ORD/159, dated 24th June, 2021.
- **IV.** Wearing of double mask or N-95 is mandatory, even for a single person driving a vehicle. In case of persons travelling in any private car, wearing of double mask or N-95 is also mandatory for all the persons. Use of sanitizers is mandatory. Proper ventilation of the vehicle is advisable.
- **V.** All Public transport authorities shall strictly enforce COVID-19 appropriate behavior and seating inside the vehicles.
- **VI.** Care should be taken at all times by drivers & passengers to ensure no breach of protocols. Smoking, eating and removal of mask is <u>strictly</u> prohibited.

Violation of any norms and advisories of the Government of Health and Family Welfare Department and this office will be liable for action as per Law by the appropriate authority.
