ORDER

In pursuance to Order No. POL.75/2020/Pt.I/112 dated. 27th August, 2021 issued by the Home (Political) Department, Government of Meghalaya, Shillong and SOP issued by the Tourism Department the following arrangement is made for commercial vehicles transporting tourists to or from East Khasi

Hills District from 6th September, 2021 as per details indicated below and until further orders:-

I. For All India Tourist Permit Vehicles:-

Vehicles holding All India Tourist Permit are allowed to ply to and from other districts / states on

compliance and as per arrangement below:

i. Vehicles registered in Meghalaya will report to respective District Transport Office for

submission and issuance of vaccination status before plying in and out of the State.

ii. Vehicles registered in other states will prominently display their vaccination status issued

by the competent authority on the vehicle before entering the State or on production of

Certificate of Vaccination or a Negative Test Report and having valid pass issued by the

competent authority.

iii. Passengers / Tourists are required to strictly comply with the SOP issued by the Tourism

Department vide No. Tourism.22/2020/Pt./69, dated 28th August, 2021.

iv. Tourist vehicles transporting families or tourists travelling as a group are permitted to

accommodate passengers as per the prescribed seating capacity under Motor Vehicles Act,

subject to other protocols being followed.

II. Vaccination Status should be clearly indicated on the vehicles as per this office order

No. C&S.2/CVD/2021/ORD/159, dated 24th June, 2021.

III. Wearing of double mask or N-95 is mandatory, even for a single person driving a vehicle. In case

of persons travelling in any private car, wearing of double mask or N-95 is also mandatory for all

the persons. Use of sanitizers is mandatory. Proper ventilation of the vehicle is advisable.

IV. All Public transport authorities shall strictly enforce COVID-19 appropriate behavior and seating

inside the vehicles.

Violation of any norms and advisories of the Government of Health and Family Welfare

Department and this office will be liable for action as per Law by the appropriate authority.
