As per point II. B (6) of the order above and in order to facilitate movement of vehicles for any emergency during the restricted period, the general public can avail <u>e-Pass</u> online on the district website "eastkhasihills.gov.in" under "E-Pass".

SMS will be triggered to the applicant once the pass is approved and issued. Applicant can track & download the e-Pass from the link given in the District website.

Movement of persons as indicated at Point II. A (7) of the aforementioned order is also permitted on self-declaration and subject to compliance to Covid protocols. Passes for movement of such cases is not required. Any persons found violating the movement protocol or furnishing false self-declaration shall be liable for penal action as per law.

Vehicular movement for passenger vehicles will be restricted as per notification issued by the Transport Department and District Transport Officer vide No.DTO/S/22/COVID-19/2042 dated 29th April 2021.
