POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:-

- 1. The Management Committee shall meet at least once in every month to consider and review:
- Care in the institution, housing, area of activity and type of supervision or interventions (i) required.
- Medical facilities and treatment. (ii)
- Food, water, sanitation and hygiene conditions. (iii)
- Mental health interventions. (iv)
- Individual problems of children and institutional adjustment. (v)
- Quarterly review of individual care plans. (vi)
- (vii) Provision of legal aid services.
- Vocational training and opportunities for employment. (viii)
- Education and life skills development programmes. (ix)
- Social adjustment, recreation, group work activities, guidance and counseling. (\mathbf{x})
- Progress, adjustment and modification of residential programmes to the needs of the (xi) children.
- Planning post-release or post-restoration rehabilitation programme and follow up for a (xii) period of two years in collaboration with after care services, as the case may be.
- Pre-release or pre-restoration preparation. (xiii)
- (xiv) Release or restoration.
- Post release or post-restoration follow-up. (xv)
- Minimum standards of care, including infrastructure and services available. (xvi)
- (xvii) Daily routine
- (xviii) Community participation and voluntary participation in the residential life of children such as education, vocational activities, recreation and hobby.
- All registers as required under the Act and the rules maintained by the institution, duly (xix)stamped and signed and to check and verify the registers in the monthly review meetings.
- (xx)Matters concerning Children's Committees; and
- Any other matter which the Person-in-charge may like to bring up. (xxi)

The Department's Notification No. SW(S) 100/2016/Pt./51 dt. 28th July,2017 stands cancelled.
