Subject :- Regularisation of appointments under Regulation 4
of the Meghalaya Public Service Commission (LOFS)
Regulations, 1972 - date of effect.

Sir,

I am directed to say that when an appointment/
promotion is made by an appointing authority under Regulation 4(d)
of the Meghalaya Public Service Commission (LOFS) Regulations, 1972
(as amended) on the recommendation of a Departmental Promotion
Committee, and when that appointment/promotion is against a regular
vacancy, regularisation is subsequently required to be made in
consultation with the Meghalaya Public Service Commission. It has,
however, been noticed in such cases that some doubt arises as to
the date from which such a regular appointment/promotion is to be
given effect to, in the absence of specific instructions in the
matter. In order to clear any doubt on the matter, it is clarified
that regular appointment/promotion, in such cases, should be taken
to be with effect from the date as stipulated in the original
Government Notification/Office Order by which such promotion under
Regulation 4(d) was made or, in the absence of a stipulated date
therein, from the date of issue of that Government Notification/
Office Order itself.
