Subject: Appointment to posts and services which come
under the purview of the District Selection Committee.

Sir,

I am directed to say that it has again been brought to the notice of the Government that some appointing authorities are still resorting to adhoc appointments against posts and services which come under the purview of the District Selection Committees inspite of the clear instructions contained in this Department's circular No. PER(AR)239/80/4g dated 21.1.83. In this connection, it may also be stated that such direct recruitment of staff on adhoc basis has already been restricted by Govt. to the extent indicated under Office Memorandum No. PER(AR)238/87/2, dated 3.10.87 and that continuance of adhoc appointments so made even after the District Selection Committees have furnished the lists of candidates suitable for appointment will be highly irregular and contrary to the procedure laid down by Government.

Further, it has also been brought to the notice of the Govt. that there are some Departments which do not notify the actual number of vacancies to the District Selection Committees and as a result, appointments to candidates duly recommended by the District Selection Committee are deprived of. It is, therefore, necessary to reiterate that suitable candidates duly recommended by the District Selection Committees should be accepted for appointments as against the vacancies duly notified by the appointing authorities to the District Selection Committees and that the number of posts sanctioned every year under different Departments should be intimated to the District Selection Committees by the appointing authorities.

The contents of this letter may be brought to the notice of all the appointing authorities under your control.

The Government will take a very serious notice of violation of these instructions.
