NOTIFICATION

Dated, Shillong the 18th July, 2013.

No. LJ(A) 77/2000/255 – In exercise of the powers conferred under rule 1-A of the Rules for Administration of Justice and Police in the Khasi and Jaintia Hills, 1937 and further under sub-section (1) of Section 2 of the Meghalaya Autonomous Districts Administration of Justice Act (Assam Act XIV of 1960 as adapted and amended by Meghalaya) read with paragraph 5 of the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution, the Governor of Meghalaya, with the approval of the Hon'ble High Court of Meghalaya, is pleased to appoint Smti M.B. Challam, District & Sessions Judge, Ri-Bhoi as the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ri-Bhoi District for the trial of all offences punishable with death, imprisonment for life or imprisonment for a term of not less than five years under the Indian Penal Code or under any other Law for the time being applicable to the District and also to hear all Civil and Criminal revisions, appeals, etc. from, the decisions of the Assistants to the Deputy Commissioners within the said District and the Governor is further pleased to direct that such District & Sessions Judge as Additional Deputy Commissioner shall for the purpose aforesaid, exercise all the Judicial powers of the Deputy Commissioner within the said District.

This supersedes all earlier notification's issued under aforesaid provisions within Ri-Bhoi District.
