**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject : Limitation on the number of escorts for medical treatment outside the State.

The matter relating to limitation of the number of escorts for medical treatment outside the State has been engaging the attention of Government for quite sometime. Consequent upon the enactment of the Meghalaya Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006 and in order to bring about uniformity in respect to the number of escorts accompanying Government employees for medical treatment outside the State, it has been decided that the number of escorts admissible for re-imbursement in case of journeys outside the State on medical treatment shall henceforth be limited to 1(one) only.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
