General Observer Brief Sector Officers of NGH

Resubelpara, March 28th, 2019 : The General Observer for North and East Garo Hills districts, Shri Anurag Pandey briefed the Police and Civil Sector officers and micro observers on election procedures ahead of the 2-Tura Parliamentary Constituency election at the Deputy Commissioner's premises on Thursday.

It is necessary to have close cooperation of all stakeholders to ensure smooth, free and fair election, said the General Observer. He also sought their support and coordination and pressed upon them to abide by the rules and regulations as mandated by the Election Commission.

Deputy Commissioner, S.C. Sadhu, Additional Deputy Commissioner, P.K. Boro and Superintendent of Police, Dr S.R. Marak also apprised the sector officers of their responsibilities and urged them to devote combine and join effort for the smooth conduct of the poll. The Sector officers comprising of police and civil were also made accustomed of their contacts so as to curtail any possibility of communication gap.

North Garo Hills district has four Assembly Constituencies viz; 37 – Kharkutta (ST), 38 – Mendipathar (ST), 39 – Resubelpara (ST) and 40 – Bajengdoba (ST) with a total number of about 171 Polling Stations.

Earlier the General Observer also interacted with the representatives of political parties at the Circuit House, Resubelpara where they were acquainted of the Do's and Don'ts needed to be observed during the entire election process.
