Guidelines

- Only original, unpublished works (photos/paintings/sketches/videos up to 1 minute).
- Maximum 3 entries per participant (including video).
- Each entry must include a caption & short context note.
- Video format: MP4/MOV, HD (720p+), max 100MB.
- Visual entries: JPEG/PNG, 300 dpi.
- Consent required for identifiable persons
- All entries become property of NALSA for awareness & archival purposes.
