Objectives

- Highlight the impact of legal aid services through creative expression.
- Provide a platform for diverse voices to share stories of justice.
- Sensitize the public on how legal aid supports marginalized communities.
- Build a lasting visual archive on access to justice in India.

Categories & Sub-Themes

Participants may choose from the following broad categories (illustrative sub-themes in English & Hindi):

- **Voices of Dignity** (Women, Children, Persons with Disabilities, Senior Citizens, Indigenous Communities).
- **Justice Where Life Happens** (Migrant Workers, Identity & Documents, Workers & Farmers, Victims & Survivors, Rural & Urban Justice)
- **Pathways of Justice** (Undertrials & Prisoners, Lok Adalats, Legal Aid Volunteers & Lawyers).
- **Horizons Ahead** (Digital Justice, e-Lok Adalats, Environment & Survival Rights).

Categories of Participants

- **Legal Aid & Justice Fraternity** – Legal Services Authorities, Legal Aid Counsels, PLVs, Judicial Officers, Court Staff, etc.
- **Students & Youth Creators** – School, college, university students & young artists
- **Community Lens** – Open to all citizens, including mobile photography.

Guidelines

- Only original, unpublished works (photos/paintings/sketches/videos up to 1 minute)
- Maximum **3 entries per participant** (including video).
- Each entry must include a **caption & short context note**.
- Video format: MP4/MOV, HD (720p+), max 100MB.
- Visual entries: JPEG/PNG, 300 dpi.
- Consent required for identifiable persons
- All entries become property of NALSA for awareness & archival purposes.
