PRESS RELEASE

On 29th January 2026, at Star Cement Ltd., Lumshnong, East Jaintia Hills District, the scientific disposal of seized narcotic drugs was carried out by the District Drug Disposal Committee of seven districts (East Khasi Hills, West Khasi Hills, South West Khasi Hills, Eastern West Khasi Hills, East Jaintia Hills, West Jaintia Hills and North Garo Hills).

The following seized drugs were destroyed in accordance with the law and prescribed environmental safety guidelines:

The disposed drugs were seized in 58 NDPS cases across seven districts through sustained enforcement actions by the police. The disposal is not merely the destruction of harmful substances, but a strong message of collective resolve to make society free from drugs and addiction.

This action was undertaken as part of the broader vision of Drug Reduction, Elimination and Action Mission (DREAM), Meghalaya which was launched by the Hon'ble Chief Minister in the year 2023.
