PRESS RELEASE

On 10th April, 2026 the Hon'ble Court of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, North Garo Hills, Resubelpara passed a Judgement ordering conviction of the accused persons (i) Shri Hamton D Shira (ii) Shri Clinton D Shira and (iii) Riksrang D Shira, for their commitment in the act of voluntary causing hurt and criminal trespass. The accused persons were convicted **U/s. 323/447 IPC** and the sentencing brings the total incarceration for each of the convicted person to 4 (four) years and 3 (three) months simple imprisonment.

The matter/case was reported at Women Police Station, Mendipathar and registered vide Women PS C/No. 08(08)2020 Under Section 447/325/354/34 IPC. The immense efforts of the officers and staff during the course of investigation have made the case a success, for which the Hon'ble Court has made a favourable judgment against the 3(three) accused persons for their criminal acts.
