CEO Meghalaya chaired a meeting with Enforcement Agencies

Shillong, March, 28, 2024: The Chief Electoral Officer of Meghalaya, Dr B.D.R. Tiwari, IAS chaired a meeting today through video conferencing with the Nodal officer of State Police, Income Tax, RBI, SLBC, AAI, BCAS, State Civil Aviation, Enforcement Directorate, Department of Posts, CISF, State Excise, RPF, NCB, DRI, CGST, SCGST, State Transport department, CRPF, Forest department and BSF.
