The event, scheduled from May 20th to 22nd, marks a significant opportunity for Meghalaya's young athletes to showcase their talent and determination.

Dignitaries included Shri Richard Yanthan, IAS, Joint Secretary, Sports & Youth Affairs department, as chief guest, Shri John F Kharshiing, Working President, Meghalaya State Olympic Association (MSOA) as Guest of Honour, Shri D. D Shira, MCS, Director, Sports & Youth Affairs department, Government of Meghalaya, Shri Finely Pariat, General Secretary, MSOA and other senior officials of the Sports Department; Police; School Authorities; Representatives of the Meghalaya Athletics Association; and students.

The programme commenced with a ceremonial unfurling marking the official opening of the three day multi sporting event.

In his address, Shri Richard Yanthan, IAS, Joint Secretary stated that, "This event seeks to recognize the power of sports and athleticism in shaping lives, especially of the youth. The government is committed towards building Meghalaya as a centre for sports excellence in the years to come, for which the government is investing on infrastructure development, and athlete development which is evident from the various schemes and policies which are being implemented".
