ADVISORY FOR RAINFALL

This is to inform all public that with the onset of the monsoon season the following are the safety precautions to be taken:-

- People are required to take extra care during heavy rainfall as there is a likelihood
 of flash floods, especially in areas near the rivers and streams.
- People are requested not to go near the waters or walk through moving water and stay away from streams, drains, culverts, etc.
- Don't drive through flooded areas and stay away from electric poles or power lines to avoid electrocution.
- 4. Students are advised not to cross rivers and streams during heavy rain.
- Tourists visiting the tourist spots are also advised not to venture into streams, rivers and waterfalls.

ADVISORY FOR HEAVY RAINFALL, THUNDERSTORM AND LIGHTNING

- Ensure safe keeping of all objects such as lumber piles, loose tin sheets, loose bricks, garbage cans, sign boards etc. which might be blown away in strong wind.
- Switch off all electrical appliances like electric iron, mobile charger, television set etc. if the lightning persists.
- People are required to take extra care during heavy rainfall as there is a likelihood of flash flood, especially in areas near the rivers and streams.
- 4. People are requested not to go near the waters or walk through moving water and stay away from streams, drains, culverts, rivers and waterfalls, etc. Currents can be deceptive and shallow, fast moving water can knock you off your feet.
- Don't drive through flooded areas and stay away from electric poles or power lines to avoid electrocution.
- 6. Do not venture into streams, rivers and waterfalls.

Advisory for tourist spots in Khasi Hills District.

- 1. Map of the tourist spot should be displayed for information of the public.
- 2. Entry and exit routes should be properly indicated.
- Tourist guides/ persons who are working in tourist spots should be trained in basic life saving skills.
- Safety audit of structures installed at the tourist spot like railings/ bridges/ kid's
 playground equipments, etc. should be regularly conducted. In case of damaged, same
 to be rectified immediately
- In tourist spots with boating facility, the boats, safety equipment and engines should be visually inspected before each use. Boats should not be overloaded. Wear life jackets during boating.
- 6. Ensure regular servicing of boat engines.
- 7. Only experienced boat handlers should be allowed to hire the boat. The owners shall ensure that people who hired the boat have adequate boat handling experience, are familiar with the operation of the skill cord and will wear flotation devices/ life jackets.
- 8. Tourist spots which allow swimming should have a life guard.
- 9. Check regular weather forecast from Indian Meteorological Department website.
- 10. Keep First Aid Box, Fire Extinguishers and Emergency Lights.
- Display the emergency contact nos (Police (100)/ Fire Service (101)/Ambulances (108) etc for public information.





Safety tips for fishing and riverside adventure

- Check weather conditions before you proceed for fishing or any riverside camping or trekking.
- Always tell friends or family of your plans-where you are going and when you will be returning.
- · Watch the water at all times as conditions can change dramatically in a short time.
- Don't venture the water into unsafe areas like deep water, slippery rocks and swampy areas.
- · Wear a personal flotation device and carry safety gear and a first-aid kit.
- · Wear appropriate shoes with non-slip soles.
- Check the rocks as they are slippery especially during the monsoons.
- · Check water before fishing.
- · Never fish alone-always fish with a friend.
- Don't drink alcohol while fishing.
- Don't swim in deep water.

Safety measures for viewing galleries/ skywalks made of bamboo materials:-

- Safety jar may be placed beneath the viewing gallery as safety precautions for tourist/ public who are climbing the gallery.
- It may be suggested that helmets should be given to all the tourists/people who are climbing the gallery.
- Number of people who are climbing the gallery should be restricted to a maximum of 5 nos subject to proper weighing and the total weight of such people should not exceed 250 kg.
- Every viewing gallery shall have an entry and exit point and the same should be clearly indicated.
- 5. People / tourists should not walk in a group while walking/climbing the gallery.
- The owner shall ensure regular monitoring of the gallery and take immediate corrective measures whenever required.
- It was suggested that the construction materials i.e., bamboos, planks, etc. used in the construction of the gallery should be replaced every 6 months.
- The viewing gallery/ sky walk should be constructed in such a manner so as to ensure that each stair is separated with a proper landing place.
- 9. The width of the stairs shall not exceed 1 feet with sturdy rail guard.
- 10. The owner shall ensure that there should be proper support in terms of trees, bamboos etc to strengthen the stairs/ gallery.
- 11. Bolt tools may be used alongwith local materials to strengthen the stairs/gallery.
- Planks should be placed in the stairs to avoid slipping.
- The Bamboos used during construction should be properly treated.





HOW TO PREVENT FIRE FROM DESTRUCTION TO LIFE AND PROPERTY.

Preventive Measures: -

- Always be cautious of open flame and naked lamps.
- Avoid smoking while retiring on the bed.
- Extinguish Cigarette ends and buds carefully before throwing.
- Isolate flammable substances & storage from the kitchen, spark and heat production equipment and rooms etc.
- Periodical check-up of all electrical Appliances & Equipment's minimise Fire hazard in the dwelling house.
- Use electronic appliances which are BIS/ISI certified.
- · Extinguish all flames and switch off appliances before leaving or retiring to bed.
- Segregate Hay Stack & straw etc, at safe distance from the dwelling house.
- Burning of crackers near the house is not advisable and must be done only under supervision.
- Match box/lighters should be kept out of reach from children.
- Burning of Incense sticks must be carefully done at safe place.
- Gas stoves and regulator should be closed properly when not in use.
- Always use original gas appliances & cylinder accessories.
- Gas cylinder should always be kept upright.
- Burning of garbage and thrash in open spaces or unattended is not advisable.
- Building Bye Laws and National Building Code should be strictly adhered to during construction.

IN CASE OF FIRE EMERGENCIES.

- Communicate & inform the nearest Fire Station / Police Station or any first responder for help.
- While calling for help from Fire Station / Police Station, remember to provide correct information for correct and immediate response; -
 - (a) Specify the type of fire (normal fire/electrical/petroleum etc.).
 - (b) Correct address.
 - (c) Shortest route and proper landmark.
- During any disaster situation, operation of the fire fighter or any responder should not be disturbed.
- Assistance may be offered only when called for.
- Always stay calm don't panic yourself.
- Overcrowding hampers, the operation of the Fire Fighters and other first responder.
- Communicate timely to the concerned authority for proper help in time.
