MTET 2025 Results Show Marked Improvement: Pass Percentage increased to 61.56 % (LP) and 63.23 % (UP) after adopting Syllabus and Assessment Reforms

(Shillong, 17 June 2025): The Directorate of Educational Research and Training (DERT), Education Department is pleased to announce the results of the Meghalaya Teacher Eligibility Test (MTET) 2025, reflecting a significant improvement in candidate performance following a four-month, evidence-based reform initiative. The pass percentage has improved from 8.11% in 2023 to 61.56 % for Lower Primary (LP) and 9.27% to 63.23 % for Upper Primary (UP), for MTET 2025.

The number of candidates appeared and passed in the MTET, 2025 is as follows:

Research-Driven Reforms Behind the Success

Recognizing the extremely low pass rates of MTET 2023, the DERT's Examination Cell undertook a systematic review of the assessment framework, guided by a team of faculty having experience in student measurement and assessments. The key interventions included:

1. Competency-Based Syllabus Redesign

- Shifted from content-heavy testing to NEP-2020-aligned competencies, emphasizing classroom knowledge and application over rote recall.
- Embedded Bloom's Taxonomy to ensure balanced cognitive demand (recall, application, analysis).

2. Rigorous Stakeholder Capacity Building

- Orientation-cum-Workshops for Paper Setters and Moderators (Dec 2024–Apr 2025) to align items with syllabus outcomes.
- Standardized SOPs for item development, including bias reviews and difficulty calibration.

 Developed items to test for depth of understanding of foundational knowledge in core papers and pedagogy.

3. Transparent Assessment Blueprints

 Introduced detailed blueprints specifying marks distribution, verbcontext mapping and inclusive language guidelines.

4. Enhanced Validity and Reliability

- · Defined test outcomes
- Item analysis
- Content validity review
- Ensuring Clear and Unambiguous Questions through guidelines and training
- Eliminated contextually irrelevant content flagged after MTET 2023 analysis.

 61.56 % (LP) and 63.23 % (UP) pass rates reflect the highest-ever MTET performance in the period from 2019-2025.
