Hon'ble Mr. Justice Soumen Sen Sworn in as Chief Justice of the High Court of Meghalaya

Shillong, October 8, 2025: Hon'ble Mr. Justice Soumen Sen was formally sworn in as the Chief Justice of the Meghalaya High Court during a ceremony held today at the Dorbar Hall of Raj Bhavan Shillong.



Hon'ble Governor of Meghalaya, C. H. Vijayashankar administered the oath of office to Justice Sen, who succeeded Chief Justice, I. P. Mukerji following his retirement on September 5, 2025.

Justice Sen's appointment as Chief Justice was approved by the President of India on September 26, 2025, based on the recommendation of the Supreme Court Collegium.
