Meeting with Political parties held to brief the present status of Special Intensive Revision in Dadenggre, Tikrikilla and Raksamgre Sub-Divisions

Dadenggre, September 14, 2026: The Additional Deputy Commissioner Incharge Election, Dadenggre Civil Sub-Division, Rajkumar Hajong convened a meeting with the representatives of political parties, Nokmas and Gaonburas of the area at the Conference Hall of Sub-Divisional Office premises on 14th September, 2026.

During the meeting, the Additional Deputy Commissioner briefed on the status of the implementation of the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR) in 44- Raksamgre (ST), 45- Tikrikilla (ST) and 49- 49-Dadenggre (ST) Assembly Constituencies.



Mentioning that draft electoral roll was published on 05- 08-2026 after which time was given to all the electors to file claims and objections if any.

He further, informed about the revised schedule for filing Claims and objections from 05-08-2026 to 18-09-2026, while the Notice or disposal of Claims and objections is from 05-08-2026 to 17-10-2026 and Final Publication of Electoral Rolls is on 21-10-2026.

Therefore, if there is any claim for the inclusion of a name in the photo electoral roll or any objections to the inclusion of names or any objections to particulars in any entries, it should be lodged between the period of 05-08-2026 to 18-09-2026 in form 6, 6A, 7 and 8 as may be appropriate.

Every such claim or objection should either be presented in the Sub-Divisional office (Election) not later than the aforesaid date or to the Booth Level Officer in your respective polling station or sent by post to the office address so as to reach the office not later than the aforesaid date.

Meanwhile, presenting the detail status report of the distribution of Hearing Notices and conduct of Hearings in respective polling stations, 44-Raksamgre (ST) Assembly Constituency has 30713 draft electors out of which 8315 Notice has been generated and 8262 Notice has been delivered while out of total 50 polling stations 32 polling stations have completed Hearing process and nine voters are found to be ineligible.

In 45-Tikrikilla (ST) Assembly Constituency, there are 35614 draft electors, 6486 Notice generated, 6465 Notice delivered and all 58 polling stations have completed the Hearing process with 46 ineligible voters.

Further, in 49-Dadenggre (ST) Assembly Constituency, there are 37073 draft electors, 9410 Notice generated, 9388 Notice delivered and out of 62 polling stations only 33 polling stations have completed Hearing process and 3 voters are found to be ineligible.
