### EKH District Organises ‘Samridhi Ki Pathshala’ at Lyngkhoi Village

**Shillong, May 21:** The East Khasi Hills district on Thursday organised “Samridhi Ki Pathshala”, an awareness campaign and field-training programme under the Government of India’s Modernization of Command Area Development and Water Management (M-CADWM) scheme of the Ministry of Jal Shakti at Lyngkhoi village under the Sohiong Community and Rural Development Block.
