Maternal Death Follow-Up and Home-Based Newborn Care Strengthened in Mahendraganj

AMPATI, SEPTEMBER 14: Dr. Noor Ain Khan, MS cum Sr. M&HO I/C, Mahendraganj CHC, on Monday visited Roghupara and Kukurmua under Mahendraganj Community Health Centre (CHC) as part of follow-up activities on maternal death autopsy and Home-Based Newborn Care (HBNC).

The visit focused on strengthening follow-up at the community level, reviewing the circumstances surrounding a reported maternal death and assessing newborn care practices and support provided to families at the household level.



Dr. Khan was accompanied by Pronoti Barman, LHV, Sheikh Latifa Nargish, PHN, Salim Miah, S.I and Imran Haque, NCD DEO.

The field visit highlighted the importance of regular home-based follow-up, early identification of health risks among mothers and newborns, and timely referral and intervention through the public health system.



The health team also interacted with families and assessed the availability and utilisation of maternal and newborn healthcare services, with emphasis on strengthening continuity of care beyond health facilities.
