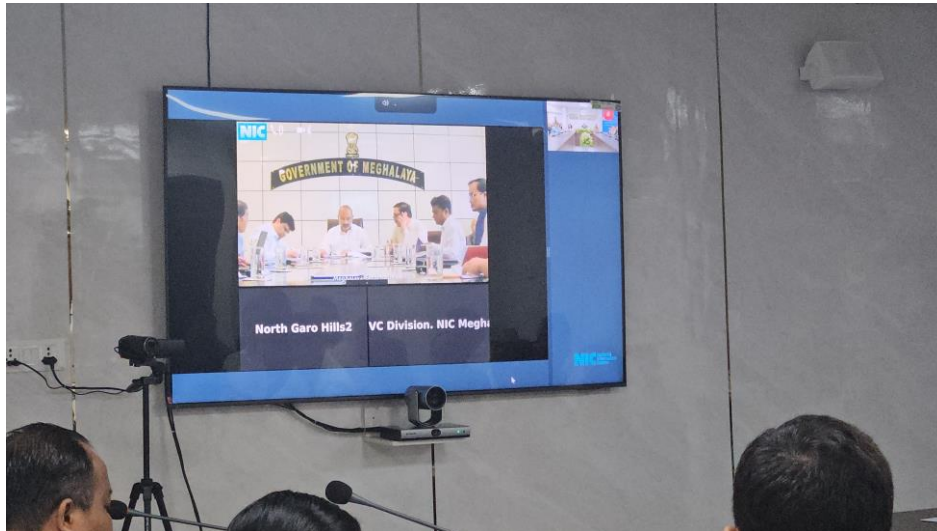

District officials during their presentation also voiced issues and challenges faced by respective departments and suggested modification of certain scheme policy to suit local condition.

After an in - depth discussion of all the presentations, the Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Bandi Sanjay Kumar assured the district officials of a 'follow - up' with higher authorities for exploring ways to enhance outreach and smooth implementation of the schemes.



Departmental schemes reviewed during the meeting were Health, PHE, DCIC, Horticulture - Agriculture, Soil & Water Conservation, Education, Labour, PWD (Roads), C&RD (MNREGS) and Social Welfare.
