MEGHALAYA GOVERNOR'S POLICE MEDAL RULES

ANNEXURE-

The Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to institute an Award to be known as the Meghalaya Governor's Police Award to be conferred on the members of the State Police Service and other Gazetted and Non-Gazetted personnel of the Meghalaya Police including those in MPRO, Fire Service and FSL and hereby makes the following rules governing the award of said Medal :-

- These rules shall be known as the "Meghalaya Governor's Police Award Rules" and shall be applicable to personnel of the Meghalaya Police as indicated in the preceding para.
- The Award shall be in the form of a Medal, styled and designated as the "Meghalaya Governor's Police Medal For Outstanding Service" accompanied with a cash Award of Rs 10,000.
- 3. The Medal will be circular in shape, made of bronze, one and three eight inches in diameter and have embossed on the obverse the image of the three swords of the Khasis, Jaintias and Garos. The name of the person to whom it is awarded will be inscribed on the rim of the Medal.
- The names of those to whom this Medal may be awarded shall be published in the Meghalaya Government Gazette.
- 5. The Medal shall be suspended on the left breast from a ribbon which will be an inch and three eighth in width which shall be half red and half Golden, the two colours being separated by a vertical silver white line.

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- 6. It shall be competent for the Governor of Meghalaya to cancel and annul the Medul awarded earlier when the recipient of the same is found guilty of disloyalty, cowardice in action or such conduct which, in the opinion of the Governor, brings the Police Department into disrepute. It shall also be competent for the Governor to restore any Medal which may have been so forfeited. Notice of cancellation or restoration in every case shall be published in the Meghalaya Government Gazette.
- 7. The number of medals awarded in a year shall not exceed ten.
- 8. The Medal shall be awarded -

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- for conspicuous gallantry in dealing with terrorists, or in saving life and property or in preventing crime or in arresting hard core criminals , the risks involved being estimated with due regard to the obligations and the duties of the police officer/personnel concerned.
- ii) for outstanding detective work.
- To be eligible for the award, a person should have completed not less than
 ' five years' service. This condition will, however, not be applicable to cases relating to conspicuous gallantry.

10. The award will also carry a lump sum grant of Rs. 10,000/-.

- 11. The award may also be made posthumously. In this case, the Medal along with the lump-sum grant will be handed over to the next of kin (as per service : records).
- 12. While wearing this Medal along with other medals and decorations, the same shall be worn to the left of the last medal awarded by the Government of India.

- 13. The HWHI'H WIll be Humanies I. the Recomment of Meghalain on the 21st January of every year.
- 14. The recommendations of the Director General of Police for the award shall be sent to Home Department, Government of Meghalaya, not later 21st of <u>October every year</u>. The recommendations should be forwarded as per proforma at AnnexureII. A certificate in the form enclosed at Annexure -"III" shall be furnished by the Director General of Police along with each recommendation :-
- 15. The recommendations of gallantry awards will be screened by a committee known as the State Police Award Committee which will comprise of the following:-

(1) Chief Secretary	20	Chairman.
(2) Additional Chief Secretary I/c Finance	-	Member
(3)Principal Secretary Home	1	Member
(4) DGP	(44)	Member

16. The allocation of award category-wise on each occasion shall be as follows :-

- (i) Police Constables and Head Constables, LNKs/NKs/Havildars, 4 Firemen, Leading Firemen, Driver, Mechanics and equivalent ranks.
- (ii) Sub-Inspectors and Inspectors and equivalent ranks
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- (iii) Superintendents of Police/Addl. SPs, Dy SPs, 2 I/Cs/Commandants, 2 Asstt. Commandants and equivalent ranks.
